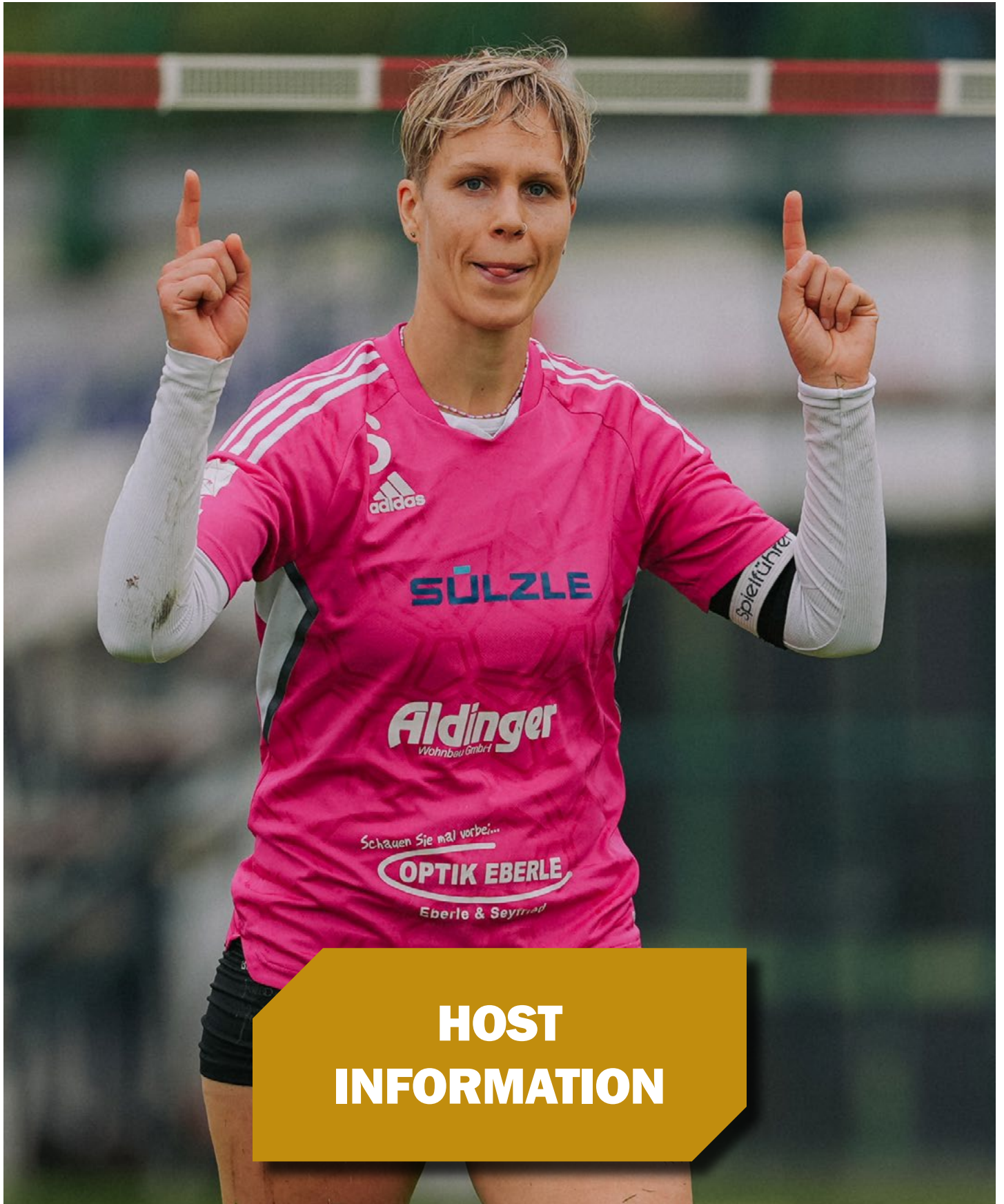

The best men's and women's club fistball teams in the world will compete in the IFA Fistball World Tour Finals.



The eight best fistball club teams each of men and women compete with top sporting performance for the World Tour Finals title: Be the next host of the IFA Fistball Men's & Women's World Tour Final!

The Men's & Women's World Tour Finals are the highest competition in club fistball. In addition to the continental champions, the best-placed teams on the IFA Fistball World Tour from the previous year also

qualify for the finals. The men's and women's competitions will be held together at one location. Eight teams each take part in the men's and women's competitions - 16 teams in total.

Highlighting and celebrating a Fistball festival for and with the best Fistball athletes in the world. Fistball is still an amateur sports and every player invest a lot of effort and money to participate in the world-wide competitions.

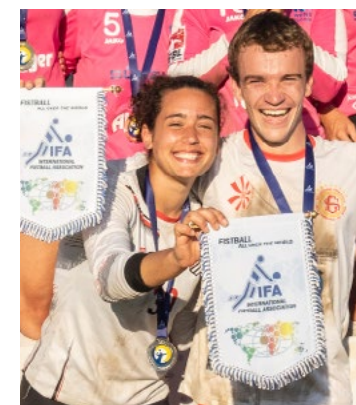

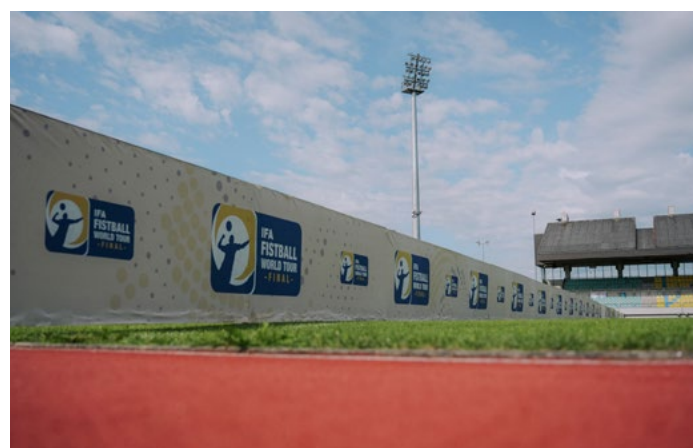

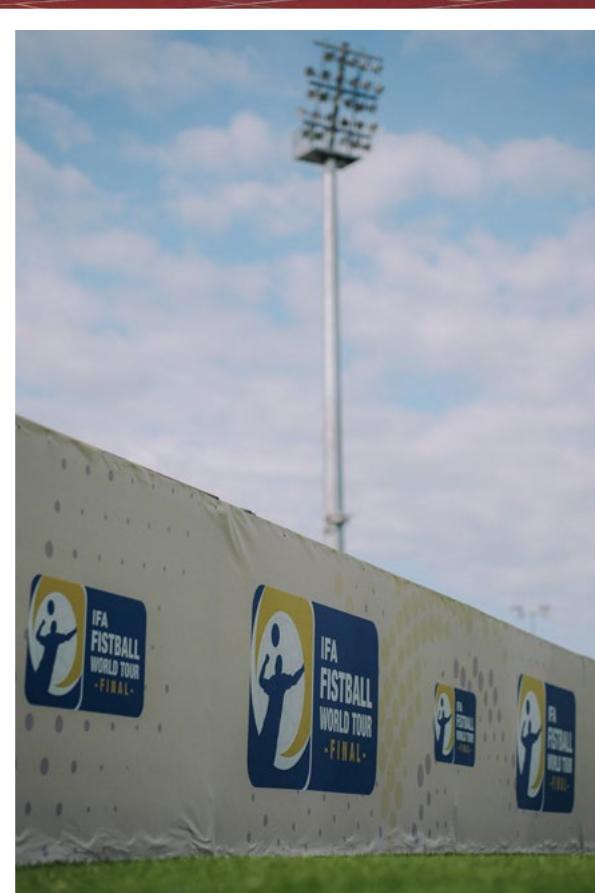
REQUIREMENTS FOR VENUE



OFFER THE ATHLETES, STAFF MEMBERS AND SPECTATORS GREAT CONDITIONS AND CREATE A UNIQUE FISTBALL ATMOSPHERE!



- ↪ 2 match courts with full run-out
- ↪ Up to 2 warm up courts
- ↪ Dressing rooms for men & women teams
- ↪ Rooms/team tents for all participating club teams
- ↪ Grand stand with minimum 700 stands & 300 seats
- ↪ Internet connection for media and TV (min. 40Mbit Upload for Livestream, min. 20Mbit Upload for Media)

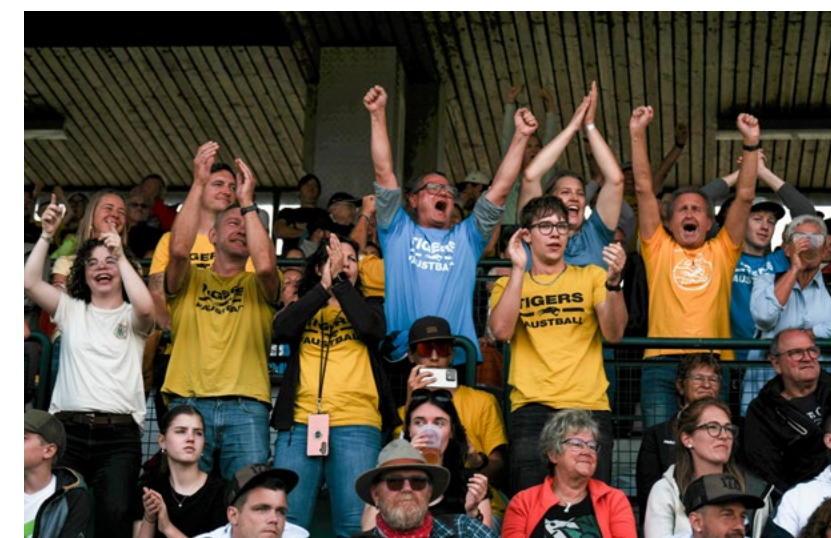


SUSTAINABILITY

ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

Our goal is to support you as a host especially in the departments sports/competition and media. The list of economic conditions is not short and for some not easy to fulfill.

Our goal is to support you as a host as good as possible with manpower and experience in several areas of the event. To do so, working staff is necessary. If you have experienced staff may it is possible to reduce the IFA staff and do a joint team of IFA and host in this departments. Furthermore, the world is different in different areas and we are glad to hear your plans and possibilities to host the event and if the economic conditions are realistic for you. We appreciate an open talk together with you to find the best solution for all and to deliver a great event for the athletes. We are looking forward to get in touch with you.

* Costs for lodging and boarding have to be covered for a period of 24 hours prior to the beginning of the competition until 24 hours after the end of the competition (for members originating from another continent, this time frame shall be extended to 48 hours prior to the beginning of the competition). Accommodation in a single room. An accompanying person has to pay the difference to the price of a double room.

Costs for transportation

- Transfer of delegations from/to nearest airport
- Transportation of the delegations from all official accommodations to the stadiums selected for training and matches.
- Transportation of Members of the IFA Board of Directors & IFA team to/from all official accommodations to the stadiums and from/to nearest airport/train station.

Ticketing

- Accreditations (incl. seating on VIP-Tribune) for all members of the IFA Board of Directors, Chairs of IFA Commissions, members of the IFA Communication Commission and IFA staff.
- Additional 15 free tickets (5 VIP tickets, 10 tickets for reserved seat) for whole duration of tournament.

Costs for protocol

- Costs for one welcome dinner for all delegations at the beginning of the event (approx. 250-300 persons)
- Optional: Costs for mementos for all members of the delegations, referees, guests of honour

Teamwear equipment

It's mandatory to provide necessary equipment (e.g. T-Shirts, Shorts, rain jacket etc.) for all volunteers. The host has to buy equipment from the official IFA teamwear partner (2025/2026: Erima). IFA provides special prices for the host.

BIDDING PROCESS & **TIMELINE**



AWARDING

IFA wants to enable a fair and transparent awarding of major Fistball events (World Championships, World Tour Finals, Masters)

Applicants for WT Finals 2030

In order to have the best possible knowledge about the host's plans how to organize the event, all applicants have to go through a special questionnaire during the bidding process before the awarding. The questionnaire consists of a total of 10 topics. The questionnaire is the same for all applicants!

A jury composed by the Sports Director, Development Director, Chair of the Youth Commission, an U18 representative and the Secretary General evaluates the answers in the individual sub-areas on the basis of a 10-part point system.

IFA wants to get an overview how you plan to host the event and this process should be also a framework for you what to deliver in case you get the event awarded by the Board of Directors.
